Schedules for the pageant will be available at the Orientation. If there are conflicts with any of the dates at that time, please let me or another pageant team person know.

# Miss Teen Norco Rules



1. Teen contestants must meet the following criteria:
  - Female between the ages of **13 to 16**. *\*Age is based on day of Pageant.*
  - Single, never married or had a marriage annulled
  - Never given birth or been pregnant
  - Never convicted of a felony
  - **You must live in Norco or attend a Norco School. Either requirement must also be met during reign unless board approves circumstances**
  - Pre sale 24 ride ticket sheets
  - Other titles held must not conflict with our pageant duties \*discretion is that of the pageant coordinator and/or director
  - Must have and maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA
  - Completed 75% of duties on court prior to year running
2. All activities are strictly chaperoned by committee members. Family members, friends and boyfriends are NOT allowed at activities or practices. Inappropriate behavior may result in disqualification. Punctuality and appropriate apparel (discussed at orientation) are expected. Contestants are responsible for having a ride to and from practices.
3. Contestants are required to sell 24 ride ticket sheets to qualify for judging. Contestants and their parents/guardians assume responsibility for all ride tickets checked out from the chamber office. Money will be turned in at the Norco Chamber Office Friday, July 30th between 12 noon and 5 p.m.

4. A panel of qualified unbiased judges from out of town will judge you. Judging is based on personality, poise, and overall appearance. Judges will choose Miss Teen Norco and four princesses to reign for one year as Goodwill Ambassadors for the Norco Chamber of Commerce. Each contestant is judged in an interview, sportswear, and evening gown (subject to committee approval for appropriateness). Top ten announced and then answer on stage question.
5. PHOTOGRAPHER'S MODEL RELEASE: "In consideration of scholarships, prizes, and/or awards, I hereby give the Norco Chamber of Commerce permission to use my name, statement, photograph and video recordings for publicity and advertising purposes. This permission extends to any person, agent and or agencies, media representatives or others authorized by the Pageant Coordinator of the Miss Teen Norco Pageant."
6. HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: "I hereby waive any claim I may have or hereafter acquire against the Norco Chamber of Commerce and any person affiliated with this organization for losses, injuries or damages suffered by me during any activities and the pageant itself."
7. In case of an emergency, I hereby give my consent to give such attention that may be necessary by a physician and/or medical personnel.
8. The Norco Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to adjust or change these rules at anytime with notification to all contestants/queen/court.

I agree to abide by all rules, regulations and with my signature make this contract legal and binding.

**Miss Teen Norco & Court  
Required Attire and Appropriate Conduct  
(Applies also to Contestants)**



The most important aspect of being a member of the court is that you are a goodwill ambassador and required to represent the community of Norco with high standards. In doing so you are a very visible role model. You will be watched, admired and looked up to. It is for this reason that the following rules and guidelines have been provided and should be followed:

1. Miss Teen Norco and her Court are not permitted to drink alcoholic beverages or smoke prior to during or after any activity. Random drug testing will be in effect for the courts if deemed necessary.
2. Dresses, skirts and suits are appropriate attire for chamber functions. Of course there are exceptions to this rule, such as the fair, consult your Director for special attire. One set of earrings only. Tattoos, belly rings, etc. MUST be covered– be conservative.
3. As a Goodwill Ambassador for the Norco Chamber and the community, you should display the best of etiquette at all times and in all places. You are a role model for young children who will admire you. Your role is very important and by winning you are forever a part of Norco’s history and future.
4. Any problems that arise should be discussed with the Pageant Director. If the Director is unavailable, contact the Pageant Coordinator or the Fair Chairman @ (951) 737-2531. We are concerned for your well-being and want to help make your year fulfilling as possible. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity, you should make the most of your year!

I \_\_\_\_\_ do hereby agree to abide by the duties, responsibilities, required attire, appropriate conduct, rules and regulations associated therewith and I further agree to:

-  Cooperate with the Norco Chamber of Commerce, the Pageant Director and /or their appointed representatives during my reign and throughout the process of the pageant.
-  Keep scheduled appointments and appearances requiring my presence in a prompt and timely manner. If I unable to attend or I am late, I will contact the Director or the Chamber.
-  Request disbursement of my academic scholarship within one year after completion of my reign.
-  Most importantly, I will serve as a positive role model and goodwill ambassador and I will conduct myself at all times in a manner that will not dishonor my title or community and I will wear my crown proudly with dignity and grace.

I have read the Rules and Regulations Contract and the Required Attire and Appropriate Conduct guidelines and agree to abide by the same. I fully understand that should I, in the opinion of the Norco Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, fail to fulfill the duties required of me, I will forfeit my title, as well as all rights to prizes and awards received by me in association with or as a result of the Miss Teen Norco Pageant and that I will be required to return these items to the Norco Chamber of Commerce.
